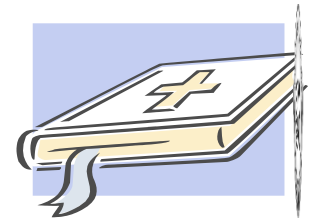

LISTELICK SCHOOL BUILDING: We wish to inform you, that all going well, the new school in Listellick is due to open towards the end of October or early November of this year. Arising from the opening of the new school a new use will have to be found for the current school building. Following consultation with the Diocesan Property Office, we intend offering this building for lease to interested parties either in whole or in part.

To this end, any party interested in taking a lease of the current school building or a part of the building should in the first instance submit a written expression of interest, made by post, and addressed to the Diocesan Property Office, Cathedral Walk, Killarney, Co. Kerry, V93 Y624 to be received no later than close of business on Monday, July 11th, 2022. Any expression of interest received after that date will not be considered. The lease will be subject to a number of terms and conditions and the successful applicant will be required to furnish written confirmation that there is public liability insurance in place and will also be responsible for the upkeep and maintenance of the property. Further information will issue to all parties that submit an expression of interest.

First Reading

'Rejoice Jerusalem.' This wonderful command shows that God's promise is addressed not just to individuals, but to his people, to his Church.

Second

Our faith holds out to us the amazing possibility of seeing God's action in our lives to the extent that instead of fearing the cross, we can, like Paul boast in it.

Gospel

Jesus wants his earliest missionaries not to be inflated by success. It follows that they should not be deflated by apparent failure. In either case, the heart of the matter is that their names are written in the book of life.
