



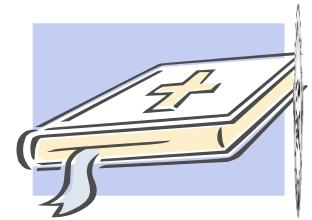

Jesus, the mediator who brings a new covenant, is the one to whom we turn in all the demands of discipleship, including our efforts to preserve and cherish God's creation.

Gospel

Jesus proclaims his message, not with severity, but with talk of feasting and celebration. There is no contradiction between the restraint the Gospel demands and the joy it promises.
