



First Reading

No sooner have they been brought out of captivity in Egypt than God's people fall into idolatry and apostasy. God resolves to punish them yet he listens to the plea of Moses and relents.

Second ReadingWhen Paul preached the gospel of mercy, he was preaching autobiographically: nobody had experienced mercy more than Paul, the one who had once tried to destroy the Church.

The sheep is lost away from home. The coin is lost at home. The prodigal is lost away from home. The older brother is just as truly lost at home, in resentment and anger. There are many ways of being lost. There is a just one merciful Father.
