

**JESSE TREE:** The Jesse tree represents the family tree of Jesus. Jesse was the father of King David. During Advent we decorate the tree with symbols that tell the stories from the Bible leading to the birth of Jesus. Each Sunday during Advent we will highlight 4 symbols to add to our tree. Many of the stories from the Bible are still relevant to us today.

- 1. **The Lamb:** represents Isaac who was going to be sacrificed by Abraham.
- 2. **The Ladder:** represents Jacob, God promised him in his dream that He would always look after his family.
- 3. The Multi-coloured Coat is the symbol of Joseph, the favourite son of Jacob.
- 4. **The Two Stone Tablets** of the ten commandments, the symbol of Moses who brought them from Mount Sinai.
