

JESSE TREE: The Jesse tree represents the family tree of Jesus. Jesse was the father of King David. During Advent we decorate the tree with symbols that tell the stories from the Bible leading to the birth of Jesus. Each Sunday during Advent we will highlight 4 symbols to add to our tree. Many of the stories from the Bible are still relevant to us today.

- 1. **Sheaf of Grain.** It is the symbol of Ruth who was the grandmother of Jesse who gives his name of the Jesse Tree.
- 2. **A Crown.** The symbol of King David, one of the greatest Kings of all time.
- 3. **A Book.** This symbol represents Solomon and his great wisdom.
- 4. **The scroll** represents Isaiah the prophet who foretold the birth of the Messiah.

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

The prophet invites even nature to join in the joyful anticipation of God's presence. May our preparation for his coming truly anticipate a time when 'joy and gladness will go with us and sorrow and lament be ended.'

Second Reading

If Advent is a time of waiting, it is, by the same token, a time of patience. St James urges patience several times in this short reading, and 'Do not lose heart.'

Gospel

John the Baptist, whom Jesus describes as the greatest of the children of men, sent from his prison cell to ask the question: 'Are you the one who is to come, or must we wait for another?' Let us not hesitate to pour out our doubts and our hopes to Christ during this Season of Advent.
