

## **INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND**

**First Reading:** 'You had Jesus crucified, but God raised him up.' This powerful statement runs like a refrain through the early preaching of the apostles. Where human wickedness brought death, God has brought life.

**Second Reading:** St Peter insists that we are a diaspora, a people 'living away from home.' As such, we are to be 'scrupulously careful' and mindful of how our membership of God's kingdom calls us to live.

**Gospel:** What was it that led two sad and weary disciples to turn right around, to retrace their steps with joy and enthusiasm? It was the encounter with Christ, in his word and in the breaking of bread.
