

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading: . 'They were cut to the heart.' It was people's grief that opened the door to their conversion. Sorrow for our sins and shortcomings can open us to God's loving invitation.

Second Reading: To bear patiently, even when life is being unfair, is not simply meritorious: it is Christlike. Christ did not retaliate; he did not threaten. He bore our sins and he bears with us.

Gospel: What kind of shepherd is Christ? He is the one who has come 'so that we may have life and have it to the full.' Let us leave aside any sense that Christian discipleship is some kind of necessary burden. It is the way to life – fullness of life.
