

## INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

#### First Reading

What is the final aim and purpose of our Christian faith? It is happiness! The prophet tells us that God will wipe away the tears from every cheek, and that we can already experience joy in anticipation of this.

## **Second Reading**

Paul's service of Christ gives him great inner freedom. His dependence on Christ gives him great independence. As a disciple, he is prepared for all circumstances.

### Gospel

The first part of Jesus' parable tells us that its not being invited that counts, but accepting the invitation. The second part tells us that there is more to accepting the invitation than simply turning up: there is a whole life, a whole inner attitude, that Jesus compares to being properly dressed for a banquet.
