

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

What sounds like a very traditional take on the relationship between husband and wife ends on a more contemporary note. Both women and men are entitled to have their work - be it inside or outside of the home - recognised and supported.

Second Reading

Many people wonder about God's timetable. When will he intervene to right the wrongs of this world? We do not know, and yet we are not in the dark, as we have the light of God's word to quide us.

A contemporary statement of the parable message might well be: 'Use it or lose it'. The point of the parable is not to compare the different gifts received by different people, but to urge each of us to use whatever gifts and energies we have in the service of God's kinadom.
