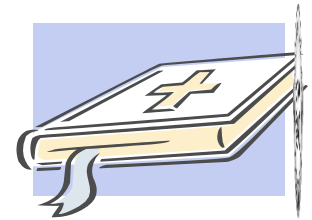

INTRODUCTION TO THE READINGS THIS WEEKEND

First Reading

God is doing something marvellous, something that can be compared to planting a seedling which will grow into a mighty tree. Let us not fear the beginnings.

Second Reading

Let us learn from St Paul, who is full of confidence even though he, like us, must walk by faith and not by sight.

Gospel

Jesus only tells us what the kingdom of God 'is like'. He does not define it precisely, as it is something that we find only by following him.
